


A total of **50 NCC volunteers and staff members** actively participated, engaging in the session and learning the benefits of incorporating yoga into their daily routines.



Enrolment of Cadets for I Year









The celebration concluded with the National Anthem, sung by all in unison, reinforcing a shared sense of national identity and pride.


Conclusion




