

Women's Counseling Cell Inauguration

- Regarding leave details, trip and safety information shall be informed.
- Awareness programmes shall be conducted along with parents.
- Ladies staff shall take care of the girls during lunch time.

Principal Mr. A. Nasir Ahamed welcomed the gathering of parents along with students and highlighted the importance of self-discipline. Sir also explained about the regulations to be followed by the girl students and requested the cooperation of parents. He asked parents to monitor students' cell phone usage and informed that no classes are being conducted online.

Then Dr. S. Sudha Ponnarasi, Lecturer/EEE, explained about the importance and need of following regulations. She also explained about bus timings and the need to utilise the free bus services offered by the college, and advised students to avoid unnecessary usage of cell phones and talks with boys. Dr. B. Vijayalakshmi explained the glory of the college and the privilege of the students to study here. She presented a small example to explain why discipline is more important than any other skill. Students were then asked to go back to their classrooms.

Discussions continued with high tea. Parents were invited to share their suggestions. Five parents came forward to give their opinions and suggestions. They are as follows:

1. Requested to extend bus facility till Vannarpettai free of cost or on payment basis.
2. Requested to allot a separate break time for girls and to provide neat hygienic washroom facilities.
3. Requested to provide a separate suggestion box for girls.

4. To organise guest lecture programmes, especially by Police personnel, for all students once in two months.

5. Requested to instruct all boys and girls not to use bad words on the campus.

After this, informal conversations were held among parents and teachers. Parents felt happy about the meeting. Thus, the meeting came to an end. Bus facility was arranged for parents for their return.
